

INTERNATIONAL SHORT FILM COMPETITION Terms and Conditions for 2020

Internationale Münchner Filmwochen GmbH will be hosting **FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2** from **November 12 to 22, 2020** exclusively as an **online edition**. For ten days, the latest productions from German and international film schools will be streamed worldwide via a DRM-protected platform. The participating films will be entered in the 2020 International Short Film Competition, where they will compete for an exclusive award. **The language of the festival is English.**

SUBMISSIONS

Films are to be submitted via the Festhome submission platform and only by festival coordinators at the respective institutions of higher education, not by the students themselves. Registration at **festhome.com** is required in order to make a submission. Each institution may submit **a maximum of 70 minutes of footage**. Eligible are training and graduation films completed in **2019** or **2020** that **do not exceed 30 minutes** of runtime each. The following documents and information must be included with the film submissions via [festhome.com](https://www.festhome.com):

1. Contact details of the person submitting: name, address, telephone number and e-mail address
2. Full name and address of the film school and contact person
3. List of cast and crew
4. 2–3 still or production photos (JPEG or TIFF file, 300 dpi, min. 10×15 cm)
5. photo of the director (JPEG or TIFF file, 300 dpi, min. 10×15cm)
6. Screening link

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: July 22, 2020

Entries that are incomplete or that are submitted after July 22, 2020 cannot be considered!

SELECTION

All films submitted will be evaluated by a selection committee. Entrants will be notified in late September 2020 whether films from their school have been selected for the competition.

UPLOAD FOR ONLINE COMPETITION SCREENINGS

Technical guidelines and upload access to the festival platform of **FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2** will be sent to entrants in good time. Films without English as their original language must be subtitled in English. Streaming will occur in adherence to DRM standards, which guarantee the strictest security and anti-piracy safeguards.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Several prizes are awarded to promote young talent. International festival juries will decide how the prizes are to be awarded.
