

SPECIAL COMPETITION: CLIMATE CLIPS AWARD
Terms and Conditions for 2020

The Nagelschneider Foundation and Internationale Münchner Filmwochen GmbH are announcing a special competition: the **CLIMATE CLIPS AWARD**. We are looking for short films that take an original and creative approach to **the subject of climate change**.

The best of these films will be screened and presented the awards at **FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2**, which will be held exclusively online from **November 12 to 22, 2020**. **The language of the festival is English.**

SUBMISSIONS

Eligible to enter are **all film students and trainees in audio and video from anywhere in the world**. Participants may submit a maximum of 5 films. The films must have been completed no earlier than 3 years prior to the start of the festival. Entries submitted to FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 2019 or prior to that are ineligible. The short films should be **at least 30 seconds, but no longer than 3 minutes**, long and must be submitted **in English or with English subtitles**. Submissions must be made via the [Festhome](#) platform. The following documents and information must be uploaded and entered:

1. Contact details of the person submitting: name, address, telephone number and e-mail address
2. Full name and address of the film school or institution offering training
3. List of cast and crew
4. 2–3 still or production photos (JPEG or TIFF file, 300 dpi, min. 10×15 cm)
5. 1 photo of the director (JPEG or TIFF file, 300 dpi, min. 10×15 cm)
6. Screening link

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS: September 24, 2020

Applications that are incomplete or that are submitted after September 24, 2020 cannot be considered!

SELECTION

A panel will evaluate all entries and decide which films are to be screened as a separate part of the festival program of **FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2**. Entrants will be notified in October 2020 as to whether their short film has been nominated.

RIGHTS

By submitting a short film and the relevant data via festhome.com, the entrants commit to the terms and conditions of the CLIMATE CLIPS AWARD special competition as well as the guidelines of FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH. Entrants agree that their short film may be published on the FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH website before, during, and up to one year after the festival. Furthermore, the Nagelschneider Foundation is entitled to present the award-winning short films on the foundation's website for an unlimited period of time after the award ceremony in November 2020 and to use them for the foundation's own purposes without remuneration. Entrants are entitled to withdraw consent to the use of their short film in writing after a period of two years.

For any other use of the short films, a separate agreement must be reached.

UPLOAD FOR FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2

Technical guidelines and access to the upload platform will be sent to entrants in good time. The directors of the short films nominated will each receive a free online festival pass.

PRIZES

The winning short film will be awarded a prize money of 4,000 €. The second place short film will receive 3,000 € and the third place 1,000 € prize money. In addition, an audience award, endowed with 1,000 €, will be presented. A jury and the audience, respectively, will select the winning films from the CLIMATE CLIPS program selection. The awards will be presented during **FILMSCHOOLFEST MUNICH 39 1/2**.

The short films will also be presented on the website of the award sponsor, the Nagelschneider Foundation, within the scope of the rights granted.
